<b>COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE</b> ( <i>Picea pungens</i> )	A pyramidal, medium to large (70 feet) evergreen with a bluish to green cast. Branches have sharp one-inch needles and 2 to 4 inch cones. Will reach 6 feet in 9 years.			☺			☂		
<b>NORWAY SPRUCE</b> ( <i>Picea abies</i> )	Fast growing to 100 feet and long-lived. Graceful tendrils are a favorite for landscapes and windbreaks. Grows to 6 feet in 7 years. Space 6 feet for windbreaks. All soil types.		f	☺					
<b>CANADIAN HEMLOCK</b> ( <i>Tsuga canadensis</i> )	Lovely ornamental with short, light green needles. Can be pruned for hedge spaced 3 feet apart. Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Does well on north facing slopes.				●	↕			
<b>DOUGLAS FIR</b> ( <i>Pseudotsuga meniesii gluca</i> )	Extra late bud break and excellent hardiness. Excellent form and density and good winter green color for all production sites							🌳	
<b>WHITE PINE</b> ( <i>Pinus strobus</i> )	Popular fast growing conifer is prized for landscaping, windbreaks, and wildlife use. Needles are long and soft. Grows to 6 feet in 7 years. Protect from deer when young.	N	f		●			🌳	🍌
<b>PIN OAK</b> ( <i>Quercus palustris</i> )	Fast-growing to 70-90 feet height, pyramidal shape, and long lived. Turkey and wood ducks favor this species. Matures. Tolerates a variety of soils.	N	f				☂	🌳	🍌
<b>RED OAK</b> ( <i>Quercus rubra</i> )	Grows to 75'. Foliage turns deep red in the fall. Acorns are about one inch long. The wood is commercially valuable to the furniture and lumber markets. Excellent street or yard tree. Does best in well drained soil with a PH less than 7.5.	N		☺		↕			
<b>WHITE OAK</b> ( <i>Quercus lbaa</i> )	Grows to 40-60'. Leaves similar to Chestnut, 4 to 8" long with pointed teeth. Gobbler acorns are smaller than regular sawtooth strains. Acorns are an excellent food for wildlife. Winter hardy. Space 20 feet apart for best acorn production. Keep site clear of competing vegetation. Disease and insect resistant.	N		☺					🍌
<b>SUGAR MAPLE</b> ( <i>Acer saccharum</i> )	Popular and long-lived shade and ornamental tree. Mature trees produce sap in spring that can be used for making delicious maple syrup and sugar. Tolerates a wide range of conditions. Mature height approximately 70 to 100 feet. Important for cavity nesting wildlife.	N		☺	●				🍌
<b>SWEET GUM</b> ( <i>Liquidambar styraciflua</i> )	Handsome trees, broad pyramidal with glossy, sharply lobed star-like leaves, brilliant crimson in fall. Grows well in ordinary, rather moist soils. Height at maturity, up to 60 feet.							🌳	
<b>WHITE DOGWOOD</b> ( <i>Cornus florida</i> )	Height 20 to 30 feet. White flowers in clusters, mid June, after White Dogwood is finished blooming. Red raspberry-shaped fruit, late summer, attracts birds. In early Spring it is covered with white-pedaled flowers, in early Fall with red berries and beautiful crimson leaves.	N				↕	☂	🌳	🍌
<b>CHINESE CHESTNUT</b> ( <i>Castanea mollissima</i> )	Hardy, blight-resistant, fast-growing tree which bears nuts. Plant two or more for pollination. Height at maturity about 30 to 35 feet.								🍌
<b>GRAY DOGWOOD</b> ( <i>Cornus racemosa</i> )	Attractive shrub grown as a single tree, dense rounded compact. Creamy white flowers, producing white berries. Tolerates moist or dry soils, sun or shady locations.						☂		🍌
<b>SARGENT CRABAPPLE</b> ( <i>Malus coronaria, Sargentii</i> )	A dwarf crabapple with clean white flowers and yellow green fruit. Grows only to 10-12', and will tolerate moist soils.								🍌
<b>SHADBLOW SERVICEBERRY</b> ( <i>Amelanchier Canadensis</i> )	Upright, multistem shrub which is excellent in the landscape or for planting in wetlands. Blooms white in early spring producing red to purple fruit. Grows to 20 ft.								🍌
<b>Northeast Perennial and Annual Wildflower Seed Mix</b>	Majority of height species is 1 to 3 feet. 2 species gets to 5-6 feet. 15 different species bloom from May until Oct. Colors are white, blue, yellow, purple, pink and red. Grow along roadsides meadows and gardens.								🍌
