Norway Spruce (<i>Picea abies</i>)	(12-18") INCHES 4 Yr. transplant	10 for \$20		

A graceful pyramidal evergreen has sharp, shiny, dark needles. Slow growth rate but will reach 60 to 80 ft. tall with a 25 to 35 ft. spread. Makes a charming Christmas tree, an appealing ornamental specimen, or a protective windbreak. Requires full sun. pH type: Acidic, neutral, slightly alkaline. Hardy tree that can grow in all soil types: Sandy, clay, loamy.

Eastern White Pine (PA) (<i>Pinus strobus</i>)	(12-18") INCHES 4 Yr. transplant	10 for \$20

A very hardy pine that grows stately and gracefully tall. Needles are soft and bluish-green in color. Bark is thin, smooth and greenish brown, turning darker as trees mature. Average growth rate with adequate moisture, growth can be 50 to 75 ft. tall, with 25 to 35 ft. spread. Needs partial shade to full sun light. Ideal for specimen planting, shade windbreaks and appealing Christmas Trees. pH: Acidic, neutral. Grows better in sandy and loamy soils.

Colorado Blue Spruce (Majestic) (<i>Picea pungens glauca</i>)	(18-24") INCHES 5 Yr. transplant	10 for \$20

A graceful pyramidal deep blue evergreen with needles. Slow to medium growing, can reach 35-60 ft. with a 15 to 25 ft. spread. Partial shade to full sun. pH: Acidic, neutral, alkaline, slightly alkaline. Soil type: Sandy, clay, loamy.

Silky Dogwood (<i>Cornus amomum</i>)	4-5 FEET 3 YR. seedling	4 for \$10.00		

A shrub from dogwood family producing good wildlife cover and feed for birds. Berries produced are a pale blue with foliage turning a deep red in the Fall. Used for borders and screens for landscapes. Grows to 8 to 10 ft. tall with an 8 to 15 ft. spread. Needs full shade to full sun. pH: Acidic, neutral, slightly alkaline. Soil type: Sandy, clay, loamy.

Apples: Golden Delicious/Gale Gala (CAN NOT SEPARATE)	4-5 FEET	1 pair for \$30		

Golden Delicious: A russet-resistant selection of the original Golden Delicious. One of the most widely planted apple cultivars worldwide. Fruit is firm, medium to large with the classic Golden Delicious flavor. The tree is spreading, productive and easy to manage. Fruit thinning is required to maintain annual bearing. A good selection for heavy, poorly drained soils. Can grow up to 20 ft. tall. Maturity Date: Sept. 23 through Oct. 10.

Gale Gala: This sport develops 90-100 percent full red color with deep red striping, allowing harvest in one or two pickings. The finish is very clean. Fruit size, firmness and eating quality are equal to other Gala sports. The tree is well anchored, hardy and size fruit well in a dry season. Can grow up to 15 ft. tall. Maturity Date: Sept. 5 through 15.

Yellow Peach: Redhaven	4-6 FEET	1 for \$15

Tree is vigorous, very bud-hardy and productive. Fruit is medium-sized and colors to a brilliant red. One of the best commercial varieties. Maturity is Aug. 2 through 15.
