### Call to Order

Chairman Gary Sawyers called the meeting to order at 7:07pm. He opened the meeting with comments about the Awards and Legislative Banquet which was held earlier in the week and discussion followed.

  - Judith Lyons was contacted by phone to discuss her request for an LOR for Anjean Rd, Roaring Creek, and Charmco. She explained that these are upcoming sediment removal sites selected by the County and she wanted the Board to be aware that an LOR would be needed in the near future.
  - Timothy VanReenen moved and Carolyn Miller seconded the motion to approve the new Emergency Action Plans for Howards Creek 12 and Marlin Run dams. Discussion ensued. # NRCS Report – Greenbrier Valley Conservation District September 21, 2017

## Farm Bill Programs

*EQIP/AMA* – Applications for EQIP/AMA/CSP have been obligated and final numbers are in. This was very good year for the Greenbrier Valley, with total contract value exceeding 2 million dollars (please note that the figures in last month's report were based on estimated values of applications).

*NWQI* – Applications for assistance in NWQI projects in the Douthat Creek and Knapps Creek watersheds have dwindled to unsustainable numbers. Despite intensive outreach efforts contacting existing customers and their neighbors, we were able to come up with only 3 small contracts in FY2017. Two of those were to repair flood damage and the third was for grazing practices that could have been covered under another fund. In a move to keep the WV from losing money for lack of participation, I recommended earlier this week that the funds be transferred to the Indian Creek Burnside Branch project in Monroe County. For this to happen, I will need a letter from the GVCD recommending the withdrawal from the Douthat Creek and Knapps Creek NWQI projects.
