Minutes of the GVCD Special Board Meeting July 26, 2018

The Greenbrier Valley Conservation District Board of Supervisors held a special meeting at 9am on July 26, 2018 at the Lewisburg USDA Service Center.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gary Sawyers called the meeting to order at 9:05am.

New Business

Gary Truex moved and Avery Atkins seconded the motion to solicit bids for the District's Ag-Air Mist Sprayer.
Discussion ensued. It was decided to solicit bids with no minimum bid, but with the right to reject any and all
bids. Bid opening to be held at the August 16, 2018 regular board meeting and bid deadline to be 4pm on that
day. Draft of advertisement was read aloud for approval. Advertisement to be placed in Monroe Watchman,
Pocahontas Times, and WV Daily newspapers for two weeks. It will also be emailed to other CDs, posted on
Facebook, and posted at the office. Motion passed.

Other Business

- Gary Sawyers noted that Judith Lyons and Ed Cox are on-site for OMR job showings today and that Judith said the debris at the Howards Creek Structure is minimal at this time.
- Timothy VanReenen talked about the strategic listening session being planned by the WVDA and said that Brian Farkas has requested information on possible locations. He would like to have the information ASAP to take with him to a meeting the first of next week. Lynn Woods will get this information to him.
- Timothy VanReenen has spoken to Louis Aspey and he has given his OK for NRCS to move forward with plans with Davis Stuart School as discussed at the last GVCD board meeting.

• The tractor presentation for Aaron Helmick will be held on the same day as the State Conservation Farm Tour, which has now been scheduled for August 29, 2018. Times are yet to be determined. Supervisors should be thinking about a budget for food and rentals.
