District Farmers Recognized

The Conservation Farm of the Year competition showcases the best examples of farms owned and operated by people who are dedicated to conservation. Farms are judged on several topics such as resource management, conservation plan, best management practices, cooperator contribution and involvement in the community. With the help of the NRCS, four district cooperator/farms were chosen and asked to participate in the competition. This year's competition featured farmers from Barbour, Randolph, Tucker, and Upshur counties. The Tygarts Valley Conservation District held their district farm tour and judging in May. The event included a tour of each farm, allowing the farmers to discuss what conservation practices and efforts they've made on their property as well as outline their production.

Poultry Litter

TVCD is offering a Poultry Litter cost share program, for litter that is shipped from within the Chesapeake Bay Watershed to TVCD. Sign ups will run <u>Monday July 15th to Wednesday</u> <u>July 31st</u>. Applications will be available at the district office and on the district's website at www.wvca.us. All applications will be ranked according to criteria set by the TVCD and will approved based on the availability of funding. Any applicants who are interested must provide a <u>current soil sample result</u> and <u>an aerial farm/tract map.</u> Maps can be

picked up from your local FSA/NRCS office.

Cooperators Participate in the Emergency Assistance for Revegetation Program

A year of above average rainfall led to muddy fields across West Virginia over the winter-feeding season. As a result, on April 9, 2019, the West Virginia Conservation Committee approved an Emergency Assistance for Revegetation program. The Tygarts Valley Conservation District announced a sign-up period soon after. Farmers applied for assistance on fields that were affected by winter livestock feeding to help cover the cost associated with seed purchases. They could request

reimbursements of up to \$60/acre with a cap of 50 acres per farm to revegetate these areas. Twenty-three farmers participated in this program on 255 acres within the Tygarts Valley Conservation District. Most farmers purchased and seeded their winter-feeding areas with either a cool season grass and legume mix or a warm season grass such as sorghum-sudangrass. Some of the sites looked very different in just a few weeks after seeding was completed.
