Century Farm Program The West Virginia Century Farm Program is designed to recognize those families who have been farming the same tract of land for at least 100 years. Century Farms, Sesquicentennial Farms, and Bicentennial Farms will be recognized. A Century Farm is one that has been in continuous operation by the same family for at least 100 years. A Sesquicentennial Farm has been in continuous operation by the same family for at least 150

years, and a Bicentennial Farm has been in continuous operation by the same family for at least 200 years. A family member must live on the farm or must be an integral part of the day-to-day operation of the farm enterprise. The farm must consist of at least 10 acres of the original holdings and gross more than \$1,000 annually from farm products. Line of ownership from the first family member owning the land may be through

wives, husbands, children. brothers. sisters, nephews, or nieces. Applications are due at your local office no later than February 1, 2020.

Soil Conservation Job Opening

The Tygarts Valley Conservation District is offering a 2-year position for a Soil Conservationist. This person will plan the application of total resource management systems, provide conservation planning assistance from initial evaluation to completion. With a practical knowledge of the methods and techniques of soil, water, and environmental conservation as they relate to agricultural operations.

Qualifications: A bachelors degree in soil conservation or related agricultural or natural resources is preferred. In some instances work experience may be substituted for education. The Soil Conservationist shall have an agricultural or other background with an understanding of conservation related work. Other required skills include the ability to perform fieldwork, manage projects, and have the ability to learn concepts related to conservation planning, surveying, design, and computer skills required.

TVCD would like to remind the cooperators who were approved for **Heavy Use Area Protection and Lime Programs**, the deadline to submit all

necessary receipts and paperwork to our district office is **December 6th. Reminder: When turning in your receipts there is a cost verification**

form that must be signed before any payments can be made. Signs ups for next years program will be Spring 2020.

A farm map from the Farm Service Agency and Current Soil test results are needed to apply.

Soil results must be within the last 3 years. Soil sample form are available at the district office as well as online. Soil sample forms have changed to obtain a new one please stop by the office or visit our website.
