Contest Guidelines

- 1. The contest is open to all amateur photographers who earn less than 50% of their income from photography. Participants may enter up to 4 photos—one per category.
- 2. Color and Black/white prints are acceptable. Reproductions (cut outs of newspapers or magazines) will not be judged. Photos should be no larger than 8 x 10 in size . If your entry is selected as a state winner, you may be asked to supply an electronic version for submittal in the National Competition.
- 3. A completed entry form and photo release form MUST accompany each photograph. (CONTACT the Conservation District to obtain both forms).
- 4. Photo information MUST be included on the back of each photo. (SEE PHOTO INFORMATION)
- 5. All photo entries must be taken somewhere in the state of West Virginia.



- 6. All entries become the property of the Conservation District, WVACD and NACD and may be used for promotional purposes. Entrants should keep negatives or extra prints of their photographs.
- 7. A judging panel appointed by the Conservation District will select the local winners.

These selections will be final. All winning entries will be sent to the WVACD photo contest where they will be judged on the state level. Winning photos on the state level will be sent to the NACD national photo contest where the NACD judges will select one national winner in each of the four categories. Some photos may be selected for Honorable Mention. West Virginia's winning photos will be displayed throughout the year. Persons taking the winning pictures will be recognized during the District Awards Recognition in fall 2020.

8. All entries must be submitted to the Potomac Valley Conservation District office by 4:00 p.m. on May 22, 2020. Winners will be notified in September, 2020.

Photo Information

The following information must be included on the back of each photo.

INFORMATION:

- 1. <u>TITLE</u>: Give the photo a title. Keep it short and simple. Print the same title on the card and entry form.
- 2. <u>SUBJECT</u>: Include the names and titles of each person in the photo.
- 3. <u>LOCATION</u>: Identify where the photo was taken.
- 4. <u>DATE OF PHOTO</u>: Exact dates are not necessary, but at least give the year.
- 5. <u>CATEGORY / DESCRIPTION</u>: Identify which category and what is happening in the photo.
- 6. <u>NAME OF PHOTOGRAPHER</u>: Include the photographers name and telephone number.
