 - Bale Grazing-This is for rolling out bales of hay in different areas for winter feeding.
 Add to the programs for CCD
 - **Cover Crop** This is a program that is not general in the county. This program can be used in a high tunnel contract. Payments and scale may be conductive to offering this the district. **Not offering**
 - Critical Area Planting-
 - Deer Exclusion Fence-this could be used under the Urban Ag program and could also be used on a larger scale producer. This program could be costly. This program is not offered under EQIP either. Add to the program
 - Exclusion Fence/Watering System (combined practice)
 - Forest Stand Improvement
 - Frost Seeding-This practice can be made available through EQIP but also having it available through AgEP helps with funding/timing on a smaller scale.
 - Hay Establishments or Reseeding- This can be included in EQIP but having it available through AgEP helps with the funding/timing.
 - Heavy Use Protection-This also can be included in the EQIP but with it available through the AgEP helps with the timing/funding on a smaller scale.
 - Invasive Species-Can again be included in the EQIP but again having it available through AgEP helps with timing and funding.
 - Lime (Liquid Lime is ineligible)-This program is definitely to keep.
