<u>Treasurer Report</u> Ms. Hedrick report that Mon District has paid their bill. Little Kanawha has been billed \$10,000.00 for mowing and we are awaiting that payment. Mr. Elliott offered to go and pick up the check when it is ready. Northern Pan. will be completed on Wednesday and will be billed for \$63,000.00 for work done on the dam. We are hopeful this will be invoiced and paid by next week. The insurance company is paying for the work to be done on the dam. We are estimating the cost to be around \$50,000.00. Mr. Shaffer moved to accept the Treasurer Reports as presented and file for audit; seconded by Mr. Nester; motion carried.

District Conservation Technician & Work Crew Report: Mr. Elliott reported the log clean out in Wheeling is completed and the seeding and mulching will be done on Wednesday and can be billed. The insurance company is covering the cost of fixing the dam. The state has requested that a plan be submitted and estimated dates as to when the work will be completed. We are using an 8-inch pump and 6-inch pump. Pumps will cost \$4,000.00 each to rent. We will also need to rent a restroom and lights. We have a job at Parsons building 2 fishing piers totaling \$46,000.00 and a hiking and biking trail totaling \$185,000.00 to be completed in 2021. Harrison County Rail Trails has 8 miles of trail work including 30 culverts that needs to be completed. They are giving us \$20,000.00 for mobilization cost and will be paying all material cost. The total job is for \$300,000.00 (1/2 being paid by County Commission and the other ½ being paid by Harrison County Rail Trails). They will be paying us every other week until the job is completed in March 2021. We have had several workers compensation claims this year which in return is going to raise our rate for next year. It was mentioned about FOIA for other districts who have had someone other than us to do the work to see what the total amount paid for work is.
