

PVCD Ag Enhancement & Chesapeake Bay FY22 Practices

Applications for the following practices will be accepted June 28, 2021 – July 30, 2021

Lime-

50% cost share of \$40 per ton max / cost share max payment \$20 per ton / 75 acre max / pasture or hay
current soil test (within 3 years)

Hay or Pasture Reseeding-

\$50 per acre / \$2,500 max per producer / 50 acre max / includes seed and equipment / current soil test (within 3 years)

Hay Establishment-

\$125 per acre / \$6,250 max per producer / 50 acre max / includes seed and equipment / current soil test (within 3 years)

HUAP- (Concrete Pads—Poultry)-

\$5,000 max per producer flat rate / Rates: \$4.50 sq. ft. welded wire fabric / \$6.61 sq. ft. rebar

Invasive Species Management-

Cost share max payment of \$500 per producer

50% cost-share on commercial application and chemicals.

75% cost share on self-application = 50% on chemicals / 25% of chemical bill in labor

Deer Fence-

50% cost share rate / \$2,500 max per producer

Cover Crops-

75 acres max per producer / cost share rate based on planting date:

\$50/ac if planted by Oct. 10

\$40/ac if planted by Oct. 20

\$30/ac if planted by Oct. 30

Litter Transfer-

\$10 per ton flat rate / \$2,500 max per producer / 250 ton max / litter must be removed from the Chesapeake Bay area

Applications for the following practices will be accepted November 2021 – January 2022

(application dates to be announced)

Frost Seeding-

\$10 per acre flat rate / \$750 max per producer / 75 acre max / Practice must be completed by 3/15 / Invoices by 5/27

Warm Season Annual Seeding-

\$50 per acre / \$2,500 max per producer / 50 acre max

If approved for this practice, producers are ineligible for the Cover Crop practice on the same fields

Nutrient Management-

Cost share rate \$20 per acre 0-0-60 / \$40 per acre 18-46-0 / \$1,200 max per producer / 20 acre max / current soil test (3 yrs.)
