- A. <u>Definition</u>: A constructed barrier to control movement of livestock.
- **B. Purpose:** To improve distribution and timing of livestock grazing. Facilitate handling, movement and feeding livestock in a pasture environment. To divide pasture fields for better grazing management such as prevent overgrazing and allow grass growth.

# C. Policies for Practice

- 1. Applicant must be a District Cooperator.
- 2. A W-9 tax form will be required with application for District tax purposes.
- 3. Applications will be accepted from January 10, 2022, at 8:00 a.m. February 4, 2022, at 4:00 p.m.
- 4. Cost share is available to owner or lessee.
- 5. Applicant must provide map identifying tract and field along with proposed acreage.
- 6. NRCS standards and specs must be followed.
- 7. Producer must follow a grazing plan after completion.
- 8. Approvals will be final on Wednesday, February 16, 2022.
- 9. Approvals will be made based upon availability of funds and based on the ranking form.
- 10. Practice must be completed by Friday, June 3, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. NO EXTENSIONS.
- 11. Receipts must be sent to the District Office by Monday, June 6, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. NO EXTENSIONS.

#### D. Payment rates & limits:

- 1. Payment rates will be based on FY 21 USDA-NRCS EQIP rates. Reimbursements are based on the cost share rates as stated above.
- 2. Maximum of \$7,000 per applicant per Fiscal year (July June).
- 3. No duplication of federal or state cost-share shall be allowed.
- 4. Practice must be complete, and receipts must be sent to the District Office by the project deadline. No extensions will be given.
- 5. The payment will be made after paid invoices are received and the AEP committee has made a site visit.
- 6. Producer will receive payment within 45 days after CD has approved payment at the monthly board meeting

- 1. Please refer to job sheets provided at the time of approval and signing of contract.
- 2. Applicant must follow a rotational grazing plan after installation of practice.
- 3. Life span of this practice is 10 years.
