The Southern Conservation District met at 10:00 AM for their regular monthly board meeting in the conference room at their location, 463 Ragland Road Beckley, WV.

Jeffrey Barr, NRCS

Jeffrey Barr updated the board that he did not submit a written report for this past month and orally reviewed current happenings within NRCS at the Southern District. He commented on the hiring process and unsuccessful fulfillment of the position for a conservation technician at this time.

Julie Stutler, NRCS

An update was provided about the upcoming potential NACD funding opportunity for grants potentially available to the district. Dennis Bailey expressed interest in the TA2022 NACD grant funding opportunity and directed Marty Walker to follow up with information from NRCS and work with Karen Brown on submitting the grant application to proceed.

Judith Lyons, WVCA

A discussion was held between the members of the board and Judith Lyons in regard to the expiration of the contract with Meadows Contracting. A letter is to be written by Marty Walker and signed by the District indicating the new terms of completion going forward notifying of passing the end date of the contract. Judith Lyons will assist Marty with the details of the letter, and they will send promptly.

An update was provided by Levi Cyphers on the sediment at Sites 4 & 5 at Brush Creek. The landowner request for additional sediment removal was discussed and will be further reviewed later and followed up on if a decision is made to assist.

Dennis Bailey commented on the situation at Site 12.

Curtis Murphy noted that he spoke with Mr. Looney as a follow up to the construction of the access road on the dam at Site 12. He obtained information from the owner that the plan was to develop the woodland above the site which is why the road to the spillway was built. He reported that DEP wrote a letter to the owner indicating that he could proceed with construction of the road. A copy of the letter will be pursued to obtain.

Bill Harris stated the terms of the easement needs to be enforced.

At length discussion was held between all parties associated with Site 12 logging road at the dam.

Donny Dodd, NRCS

Donny Dodd reported on the Watershed Associations in the district and upcoming sponsorship towards construction costs. More information will be following in the conference call today at 1:00 PM

Dennis Bailey commented his appreciation to Heather Duncan for her hard work and updates to the district.

Southern Conservation District Operations & Business

Bill Harris reported that the quarterly meeting is scheduled for January 18, 19 and 20th of next week weather pending in person. Links have been sent to Marty Walker from the association that be dispersed for those who wish to attend via teleconference.

Dave Parkulo, Conservation Technician Supervisor Report

Dave Parkulo updated the board on the SCD janitorial services notice that has distributed in the building. He reported that he has completed all the AgEP cost share work at this time except for one fence project that is on the request for service list to be completed weather pending.

The crew is currently completing routine maintenance on the equipment.

He noted that channel cutting permits are awaiting to be received, weather permitting he could begin cutting in winter months.

Dave Parkulo reported that he has received a call from a delegate in Mercer County pertaining to a blockage in Mercer County. He will be following up on this site with the assistance of County Commission.

Randall Patton reported on the profit-loss statements he has requested from Akers Associates and the planning for the truck and trailer equipment purchase through financing at MCNB.

Randall Patton moved to approve the purchase of SCD crew truck and trailer up to \$55,000, Fred Halsey seconded, motion carried.

Dave Parkulo commented that it was the recommendation of the equipment committee to raise the rental prices.

Randall Patton moved to approve the increase from \$90.00 per day to \$100.00 per day, Curtis Murphy seconded, motion carried.

Marty Walker gave an oral review of Jeremy Salyer's written report as he was not able to attend the meeting due to a conflicting schedule of another board meeting.
