SCD Office Updates

Marty Walker-Owen provided an update on upcoming timelines with programs. She reported as a reminder the conservation farm tour deadline to submit a district farm is May 31st and stated now is time to be working with county farms in preparation partnering with AgEP and NRCS clients. She asked that everyone help think about producers in their counties to recommend.

Marty reported that the personnel plan and CDO budget previously discussed will need approved at the committee meeting to be submitted for the SCC meeting in April changing to a Special Board Meeting for other approval items needed as well.

She noted she would be working with the SCD bookkeeper and district fiscal as well as her own records to complete the CDO budget in the next few weeks for their review at end of March.

Marty commented she has sent out four Century Farm packets but has only received one in return completed for submission by April 1<sup>st</sup>.

She gave an update on the current CD dates of maturity for renewal per request of Randall Patton. CD renewals are coming due April 14<sup>th</sup> and May 3<sup>rd</sup> 2024 for the OMR CDS and the District CD.

Review/Approval of Co-administered WVCA Financial report

Conservation Technician Supervisor Report District Work Project Updates

Dave Parkulo, SCD

Dave Parkulo provided an overview of the conservation crew projects completed since last month including fence project at Patterson Creek #41 for the PVCD, farm work project in Wyoming County, Howards Creek brush cutting and lime tonnage delivered to Fayette and Raleigh Counties about 35 tons.

He reported he has completed the silt fence installation at WorkForce property in Beckley from the culvert project.

A water system project is being concluded in Raleigh County.

He commented that he has completed all mowing estimates for the Western District (7) and Potomac Valley District (25) as well as a herbicide plan for two of Western's dams. He reported

that Little Whitestick Channel, Cranberry Creek Channel and Soak Creek channel mowing estimates have also been completed.

Trash rack installation of replacements will be done on Brush Creek site 12, 10 and 6.

Dave reported he has been in meetings with Braden Snyder and Ron Testerman to create a revised feedpad design plan due to original submission not being functional.

He updated the board on the pursuit of cyber insurance for the direct deposit of employees he and Marty are working on .
