



WVACD ROOKIE SUPERVISOR AWARD

This award is designed to recognize outstanding and exemplary first time, (Rookie) Conservation District Supervisor achievements and leadership in the protection and enhancement of West Virginia soil and water resources. Any ***newly elected or appointed*** District supervisor currently serving on a local West Virginia Conservation District Board is eligible to be nominated. A newly elected supervisor is a supervisor who is in their first term (eligibility period – June 30th to July 1st) and who has never previously served as a district supervisor.

Entry Procedure: Nominations may be made by any individual, organization, agency or conservation partner. An entry form must be completed along with a narrative (on a separate page) of 1,000 words or less stating why the nominee is deserving of the Rookie Supervisor Award.

Supporting Materials: Materials such as articles, photos, etc. that support the supervisor's achievements and leadership are encouraged to be sent as a supplement to the application. All materials (online application and supporting documents) are due by September 1st.

Recognition: One state winner will be recognized at the annual Conservation Awards Ceremony during the Annual Meeting in October.
